Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures: Blue Zone (Grades 7-9)

The safety of your child(ren) is one of our top priorities; therefore, please follow drop-off and pick-up plans prepared by the Parent Organization Safety Committee for each individual campus. We will do everything in our power to maintain quality traffic flow without compromising safety. Thank you for your adherence to the guidelines. Please remember that students must be picked up immediately at dismissal or following an after-school program. (Courtesy of the SAA Student-Parent Handbook)

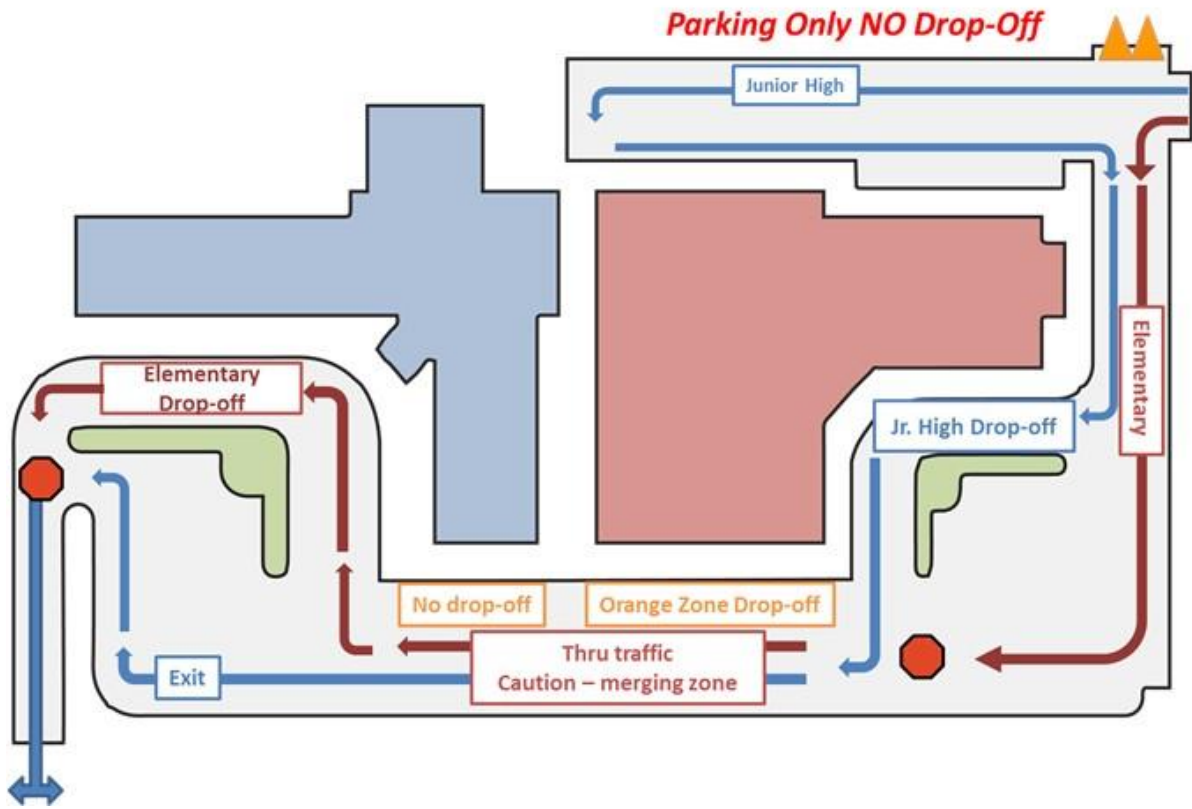
Exceptions to Safety Guidelines must be approved by the Parking Lot Duty Coordinator to assure minimal impact on safety and traffic flow. Thank you for your cooperation.

Safety Guidelines:

- **SPEED LIMIT IS 10 MPH.**
- Cell phone use is **prohibited**. Smoking or vaping on school property – even in your vehicle – is **not** allowed. Please do not bring pets with you to drop off or pick up students.
- **DO NOT** drop off on 3000 W, Antelope, or Bluff. Signs are posted. Violators can and WILL be reported to Syracuse City police.
- Students must exit and enter the vehicle **curbside**. Parents may not exit vehicles while in the drop-off and pick-up lanes. If you need help, please ask a volunteer or pull to the front of the line.
- Students must wear seatbelts while in a moving vehicle. Buckle up to stay smart!
- Drop off and pick up only in designated areas. Drop off and pick up is NOT allowed in the horseshoe. Drop-off and pick-up in the overflow parking lot is at your own risk.
- Cross only at marked crosswalks. *There is no crosswalk from the overflow parking lot to the school.* Parents and students must walk around the horseshoe.
- Follow instructions given by Parking Lot Volunteers. Complaints will be directed to the Parking Lot Duty Coordinator. Excessive violations of Safety Guidelines may result in administration involvement and/or being restricted from school grounds.
- **DROP-OFF:** If you have students in both Junior High and Elementary, you may either go through both zones OR choose to drop off in front of the Elementary School in either Green or Orange Zones. Drop-off in Orange Zone is allowed ONLY BEFORE the big green box. When pulling out of Orange Zone, yield to oncoming traffic. *Note – drop-off in Orange Zone can be difficult to navigate.
- **Pick-Up Zones are determined by the grade of your youngest SAA student. Older students are to meet younger students for pick-up. (Example: your Junior High student would meet your 2nd Grade student in Yellow Zone)**
